STATEMENT 87/06**Statement by France**

"France deeply regrets the discriminatory manner in which the Commission has treated the requests made at the December Council meeting for special conditions (derogations) regarding the maximum number of days at sea for the use of certain gear. France would point out that in a statement which is annexed to the Council minutes, and an integral part of the compromise, the Commission undertook to examine France's request rapidly in the light of the scientific evidence provided by France.

France deplores the fact that the Commission has yet to fulfil that commitment, despite the fact that the French authorities forwarded the necessary data in good time, some of it before the December 2005 Council meeting.

France therefore reiterates its requests and stresses their urgency. It confirms the scientific evidence demonstrating the justification for these requests and stresses their extreme importance for the activities of the small-scale fleets concerned. It calls on the Commission to do everything possible to resolve this issue satisfactorily."

STATEMENT 88/06

Statement by the Commission

"In the context of the work on a specific Commission Directive relating to sports foods, including sports drinks, the Commission undertakes to address the question of the use of sweeteners in such products."

STATEMENT 89/06

Statement by the Commission

"The Commission declares that it will make full use of its competence to adopt emergency measures under Chapter IV, section 2 "Emergencies" of Regulation No 178/2002/EC (The Food Law), if the European Food Safety Authority advises that a food additive is not safe for the consumer."

STATEMENT 90/06

Statement by the Council

"The Council considers that all additive uses of sulphur dioxide and sulphites should be reviewed to ensure that the acceptable daily intake (ADI) is not exceeded. It invites the Commission to take the necessary measures to initiate this examination as soon as possible."

STATEMENT 91/06

Statement by Denmark

"Denmark generally supports the common rules on additives and welcomes the Commission's current initiative to amend the rules which by and large are based on the scientific advice for the use of additives. Denmark – which as is known has always been opposed to current EU rules on nitrites and nitrates because of the carcinogenic properties of these substances, and which has been allowed by the EU Court of Justice to retain national rules in that area – has been looking forward with great interest to the Commission's proposed amendments. However, Denmark has been unable to support either the Commission's proposal or the compromise text put to the vote at the Council meeting. Denmark considers it an improvement on the current rules that the use of nitrites and nitrates will henceforth be regulated in terms of added amount instead of residual amount. However, Denmark has been unable to endorse the proposal, as in its view the allowable limit values for the use of nitrites and nitrates are too high and therefore continue to run counter to the scientific advice given inter alia by EFSA. Moreover, Denmark takes the view that these rules go too far with regard to traditionally-manufactured products which no longer constitute a clearly-defined and minor group of products."

STATEMENT 92/06

Statement by Belgium

"Belgium cannot vote in favour of the draft Directive. Although we support the major part of the draft Directive, we have a reservation on the proposed revision table for nitrite and nitrate in meat products. Although we were open for improvements and did constructive proposals during the discussions, we now face the problem that the finally proposed revised rules are extremely difficult to understand, contain contradictions and contain less protective maximum levels for public health. As a consequence, it is in the interest of consumers, authorities and companies to prefer the current harmonised legislation (the original Directive 95/2) above the revision proposal."

STATEMENT 93/06

Statement by France

"Although France supports the text, it wishes to reaffirm its commitment to the financial integration of Europe as one of the European Union's objectives under the Lisbon Agenda and the Financial Services Action Plan (FSAP). In this respect, France is still in favour of the principle of consolidated supervision, which would leave overseers the option of requesting a calculation of the ratio on an individual or sub-consolidated basis where the prudential situation of the group so justified, as well as a standard weighting (i.e. 0%) for intra-group exposure, irrespective of whether subsidiaries are located in the same Member State or in another. So that the constraints on institutions do not translate into a competitive disadvantage for European banks operating at international level, it is essential that the "rendez-vous" clauses which the text provides for in respect of these points make it possible to progress towards a more integrated approach."

STATEMENT 94/06

Statement by Hungary

"Hungary welcomes the new approach for capital adequacy in the financial sector, which ensures that credit institutions and investment firms will be able to use methods with higher risk sensitivity for the calculation of capital requirements. The new approach contributes to the strengthening of overall financial stability.

However, Hungary would like to remind Member States of the fact that the option not to apply requirements on an individual basis to a parent undertaking, in accordance with Article 69(3), may have undesirable effects on its subsidiaries in other Member States. Hungary is of the opinion that Member States should be able to exercise such a waiver only if all institutions of a group operate in one and the same Member State."

STATEMENT 95/06

Statement by Finland

"Finland declares that it will apply the provisions of the Directive which assign discretionary powers to the competent authorities in the choice of regulatory options subject to the necessary restrictions that are required by the Finnish Constitution when legislative powers that belong to the Finnish Parliament are delegated to other authorities.

Finland declares that it will apply Article 136 of the Directive [Recast 2000/12/EC] subject to the necessary restrictions that must be applied to any exercise of public authority by virtue of the Finnish Constitution."

STATEMENT 96/06

Statement by Poland

"Poland considers that reaching agreement on the newly recast capital requirements Directive constitutes an important step towards the completion of the Financial Services Action Plan. The new Directive should contribute to the development and stability of the financial sector by introducing an improved approach to the calculation of capital requirements.

Nevertheless, Poland would like to put on record its concern about the wording of Article 69(3) (and, in consequence, also of Article 69(4)) of the said Directive. In our view, the application of these provisions may lead to a situation in which a subsidiary will have to guarantee with its own capital resources the safety of its parent undertaking. Such practices may have negative consequences for the activities and effective functioning of the subsidiaries, and – consequently – for the overall stability of the financial system of a host Member State."

STATEMENT 97/06

Statement by the Commission

"The Commission intends to examine the possibility of enhancing the existing rights under Community, national or international law of air passengers whose wheelchairs or other mobility equipment are destroyed, damaged or lost during handling at an airport or during transport onboard aircraft. A respective study will be launched to address in particular the issue of compensation thresholds for damaged or lost equipment and devices. The Commission intends to report on this study to the European Parliament and to the Council by 1 January 2008. If necessary, the Commission will make appropriate legislative proposals."

STATEMENT 98/06

Statement by the Commission regarding Article 11(4)

"The Commission declares that the wording in Article 11(4), as distributed in the meeting of the Special Committee on Agriculture on 6 June 2006, intends to permit the Commission to maintain the status quo regarding the marking of eggs."

STATEMENT 99/06

Statement by Poland, supported by the Czech Republic, Lithuania and Finland

"Poland considers that class B eggs should be marked in a way which would enable consumers and traders to distinguish class A eggs from class B eggs. This is necessary in order to prevent fraudulent practices in trade and secure the interest of consumers."

STATEMENT 100/06

Statement by the United Kingdom

"The UK believes that the new definitions set out in this Regulation are inappropriate when applied to intra-Community movements of toothfish. The UK's abstention therefore reflects the fact that the UK had no difficulties with the principle of the draft Regulation, but regarded some of the technical content of the text as inappropriate.

The UK believes that the principle of free internal movement of goods will be overridden by the Council Regulation.

The proposed amendments to Council Regulation EC No 1035/2001 mirror those adopted by CCAMLR in its Conservation Measure 10-05 in November 2005. However, those definitions cause technical difficulties when applied to intra-Community movements. The terms "export" and "re-export" explicitly refer not just to "the geographical territory under the control of a State", but also to "free trade zone of landing" and "customs union". However, the definition of "import" is silent on these latter terms referring instead only to the "geographical territory under the control of a State". The verbatim incorporation of the definition of "import" adopted by CCAMLR into Community law would therefore seem to overturn the practice to date of regarding intra-Community movements as not constituting "imports".

We believe that the definition of "import" in the Regulation should, as appropriate, have been tailored to the needs of EU Member States. This we believe could easily have been accomplished by minor amendments to the draft Regulation without in any way undermining the intent behind the CCAMLR Conservation Measure."
