Statement by Bulgaria, Cyprus, Estonian, Greece, Spain, Croatia, Italy, Lithuania, Latvia, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia and Slovakia

on Next Generation-EU interest payments

“BG, CY, EE, EL, ES, HR, IT, LT, LV, MT, PL, PT, RO, SI, SK recall point 16 of the European Council conclusions of February 2024 which introduced the cascade mechanism and established EURI instrument with the aim of ensuring that the Union Budget fulfils its legal obligation taking into account commonly agreed priorities and prudent budgeting.

We emphasise that the provisions regarding the use of step 2 require to cover a substantial part of the necessary amounts, as far as possible, with a view to mobilising an amount equivalent to about 50 % of the NGEU interest payments cost overruns as a benchmark, taking into account priorities and prudent budgeting at the same time. We point out that exceeding the 50% benchmark may not be in line with the above-mentioned limitations. Excessive reductions of funding for EU programmes (including Erasmus+) may negatively impact EU priorities and excessive use of margins and special instruments may not be in line with prudent budgeting.

BG, CY, EE, EL, ES, HR, IT, LT, LV, MT, PL, PT, RO, SI, SK recall that following the submission of the amending letter, and the updated information regarding the Next Generation EU and implementation of the programmes, we would take these into account in our positions, notably with respect to programmes and priorities, and the use of margins and special instruments. We emphasise that the implementation of the cascade mechanism in the 2025 EU budget should not set a precedent for the coming years and that the Council’s overall position on future annual budgets should not be prejudged by the implementation of the cascade mechanism in 2025.”
