<i>Council Decision, Regulation and Implementing Regulation concerning restrictive measures against serious human rights violations and abuses - Statement by Hungary</i>	CM 2418/24
Hungary welcomes the Coreper approval of the restrictive measures under the EU Global Human Rights Sanctions Regime against Hamas entities responsible for the brutal and indiscriminate terrorist attacks across Israel since 7 October 2023. As revealed in the reports of the UN Special Representative, the terrorist group is responsible for carrying out heinous acts of widespread and systematic sexual and gender-based violence across Israel, and their terror is felt, to this day, by the many hostages still held captive. With regards to the further listing proposals under the same sanctions regime concerning violent settlers, Hungary reiterates its concerns regarding the timing and adequacy of their adoption. Furthermore, Hungary wishes to reaffirm that Israel is a democratic country with a legal system that guarantees the accountability of perpetrators of human rights violations and abuses. In light of the above and in accordance with the fourth paragraph of Article 238 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, Hungary will abstain in the vote on the corresponding legal acts.
