"The Commission commits itself to securing that the provisional measures will be implemented in the spirit of its purpose and thus to the benefit of certain tropical fishery products. The Commission therefore commits itself to proposing a draft Council Regulation which would exclude the cold water-type shrimps (HS ex 1605.20.10) from the present Regulation if this were to become justified due to a significant increase in exports from developed countries of these prepared shrimps."
