Subject:	Appointment of three Member States' representatives of the Management Board of the European Food Safety Authority

1. In accordance with Article 25(1) of Regulation (EC) No 178/2002¹, each Member State should nominate a member and an alternate member as its representatives to the Management Board of the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA). The members and alternate members nominated by each Member State are appointed by the Council.
2. The Council, by means of its Decision of 7 April 2022², has appointed representatives of Member States as members and alternate members of the EFSA Management Board for the period from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2026.
3. On 1 May 2022, Mr Georgi GEORGIEV, the member for Bulgaria, passed away.
4. By letter of 23 August 2022, Ms Patricia REILLY, the alternate member for Ireland, presented her resignation.

5. By letter of 15 September 2022, Ms Jitka GÖTZOVÁ, the alternate member for Czechia, presented her resignation.
6. Three new representatives should therefore be appointed to serve for the remainder of their predecessors' term of office.
7. The members and the alternate members of the Management Board shall be nominated and appointed on the basis of their relevant experience and expertise in the field of food chain law and policy, including risk assessment, whilst ensuring that there is relevant expertise in the fields of managerial, administrative, financial and legal matters within the Management Board³.
8. By 16 September 2022, the Republic of Bulgaria, the Czech Republic and Ireland have informed the Presidency and the General Secretariat of the Council of the names of their representatives as members and alternate members of the EFSA Management Board.
9. The Presidency and the General Secretariat of the Council have assessed the supporting evidence submitted by the delegations and concluded that the experience and expertise of the nominees fulfil the requirements outlined above.
10. Delegations are therefore informed that the Presidency will present a draft appointment decision in due time to the Permanent Representatives Committee (Part 1), for possible endorsement.
