"The Commission considers that the notification to the Government of Japan stating that the European Union will not be completing the internal procedures necessary for the approval of the Anti-Counterfeiting Trade Agreement, which necessarily follows from the negative vote by the European Parliament and the subsequent withdrawal of the proposal to conclude, is an act of external representation of the Union, which, in accordance with Article 17(1) TEU, is the institutional prerogative of the Commission.

It is recalled that the Court of Justice has emphasised that consistent practice by Union institutions that is not in accordance with the EU Treaties 'cannot alter the rules of the Treaties that the institutions are obliged to respect' (Case C-687/15 Commission v Council, EU:C:2017:803, para. 42).

#### Statements by the Commission

"The Commission considers it legally incorrect that a Council Decision authorising the opening of negotiations indicates a substantive legal basis.

The Decision authorising the opening of negotiations is premised solely on the existence of conferred powers of the Union and not on a determination of a specific competence. Its effect is limited to authorising the Commission or the High Representative, as the case may be, to use its prerogatives under the EU Treaties in order to start negotiations. The scope of these negotiations is therefore determined by the scope of the powers of the Union. Besides, the freedom of the envisaged treaty partner of the Union as regards the determination of the scope of the negotiations. Thus, the precise legal basis for the future agreement can only be determined after the content of the agreement is known.

The Commission reserves all its rights in this regard."

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"As a matter of principle, the Commission is not in favour of extending existing Protocols, as such extensions significantly decrease the EU leverage during negotiations.

In the very specific current circumstances of the negotiations of a new Protocol to the Fisheries Agreement with Mauritius, the Commission can accept the Presidency's compromise allowing an extension to continue EU fishing activities in Mauritius waters after the expiry of the protocol, in case negotiations prove challenging and cannot be concluded in time, and provided that such extension is limited to maximum 6 months. Furthermore, the Commission underlines that such exception should not be repeated and that its acceptance shall not be considered as creating a precedent."

## Statement by Croatia

"Croatia fully supports tax transparency. Nevertheless, as some other Member States, Croatia is of the opinion that Article 115 of TFEU would be a more appropriate legal basis than Article 50(1) TFEU. Croatia fully shares the opinion of the Council Legal Service of 11 November 2016 (with reference to 2016/0107 (COD), FISC 194) stating that the proposal for a Directive amending Directive 2013/34/EU as regards disclosure of income tax information should be based on Article 115 of TFEU since both the aim and the content of the proposal relate to "fiscal provisions", and is of the view that accordingly, the proposal should have been discussed at ECOFIN Council, taking due account of the relevant procedural rules.

Furthermore, Croatia is of the opinion that the agreed amending Directive should not become precedent for qualified majority voting in the future decision-making processes with regard to tax matters."

Statement by Cyprus, Czech Republic, Hungary, Ireland, Luxembourg, Malta and Sweden

"Notwithstanding the general support expressed by all for tax transparency and the constructive discussions facilitated by the Presidency, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Hungary, Ireland, Luxembourg, Malta and Sweden have ongoing concerns regarding the legal basis of this Proposed Directive, and consider that the proposal for a Directive amending Directive 2013/34/EU as regards disclosure of income tax information must be based on Article 115 TFEU since both the aim and the content of the proposal relate to "fiscal provisions", rejecting thereby the appropriateness of the legal basis of the initial proposal, i.e. Article 50(1) TFEU."

## Statement by Belgium

"Belgium supports the proposal as it stands now but we would like to raise a concern. Until now, the regulation (EC) No 853/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 29 April 2004 laying down specific hygiene rules for food of animal origin allows the direct sale on the farm, without expertise, of fresh poultry and rabbit meat. Due to the proposed change, direct farm sales, without expertise, will be extended, for example, to minced meat from poultry and rabbit. Due to the sensitivity of these products, we think it is dangerous to produce them on the farm without expertise and control."
