REMARKS:

On 13 January 2022, the Commission informed the Council of the intention to negotiate with Ukraine and Moldova in order to enter into high-level understandings within the meaning of Article 49(6) of the TEN-T Regulation on behalf of the Union, as concerns the adaptation of the indicative maps of the transport infrastructure networks in Ukraine and Moldova.

The negotiations have now been concluded successfully. The Council will find enclosed the texts and maps as negotiated. In conformity with the purposes and structure of Article 49(6) of the TENT Regulation, the form and the title of the text is that of a non-binding agreement setting out political commitments.

The Commission hereby requests the Council to endorse the enclosed draft texts of the high-level understandings in order to allow for the signature by the Commission on behalf of the Union, as well as by Ukraine and Moldova, as soon as possible.

After signature on behalf of the Union, the Commission would be entitled, under Article 49(6) of the TEN-T Regulation, to adopt a delegated Regulation on the adaptation of Annex III of the Regulation, with a view to adapting the indicative map of Ukraine and Moldova.
