Subject:	Council Conclusions on the application of the EU Charter of Fundamental Rights 2017

1. In June 2018, the Commission adopted its 2017 Report¹ on the Application of the EU Charter of Fundamental Rights, and the EU Agency for Fundamental Rights adopted the Fundamental Rights Report 2018².

These reports were presented and discussed at the meeting of the Working Party on Fundamental Rights, Citizens' Rights and Free Movement of Persons (FREMP) on 12-13 June 2018.

- 2. On the basis of the reports, the Presidency prepared a set of draft Council conclusions that were examined at the FREMP meetings on 12-13 July, 10-11 and 19 September 2018.
- 3. On 3 October 2018, COREPER discussed the Presidency compromise text (doc. 10756/3/18 REV 3) and concluded that further work was needed to reach an agreement.
- 4. A revised version of these draft conclusions (doc. 10756/4/18 REV 4) has been issued by the Presidency.
- 5. In the light of the above, COREPER is invited to agree on the draft conclusions, as set out in document 10756/4/18 REV 4, and to submit them to the Council (Justice and Home Affairs), (as document 12284/18) for adoption.
- 6. The Council is invited to adopt these conclusions.
