| Subject: | Renewal of the Management Board of the European Agency for Safety and Health at Work (EU-OSHA) |

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1. The term of office of the members and alternate members of the European Agency for Safety and Health at Work (EU-OSHA), will expire on 31 March 2023<sup>1</sup>.

Under Article 4(5) of Regulation (EU) 2019/126<sup>2</sup>, the Management Board must be renewed for four years. Members' and Alternates' terms of office are renewable.

2. Article 4(1) of that Regulation provides that the Management Board shall be composed of three members from each of the Member States, as follows:
  - one representative of the government,
  - one representative of the trade unions,
  - one representative of the employers' organisations.

In accordance with Article 4(2) of that Regulation, for each of the categories referred to above, one alternate member is appointed for each Member State, totalling three alternate members each.

3. In accordance with Article 4(1) of Regulation (EU) **2019/126**, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council. **However, members and alternate members must be members of the Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work.** The members representing the governments are appointed on the basis of candidates designated by the Member States, while the members representing the employers' and employees' organisations are appointed on a proposal by the respective groups' spokespersons in the Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work.

To that end, each delegation is asked to submit to the General Secretariat of the Council (LIFE.4, Employment and Social Policy Unit), for the attention of Ms Maria KAVOUNI, email: maria.kavouni@consilium.europa.eu, and to the functional mail-box: LIFE 4 Social Committees, e-mail: LIFE.Socialcommittees@consilium.europa.eu, by 10 February 2023 at the latest, a list comprising:

- one candidate for the seat of member and one candidate for the seat of alternate member for each of the three categories listed in paragraph 3, i.e. three members and three alternate members.

It is important that this deadline should be respected in order to ensure the timely renewal of the Board.

4. Delegations should note that the lists of candidates sent to the General Secretariat must give surnames, forenames, job titles, postal addresses, telephone and e-mail addresses.
