	 Adoption of the legislative act

- On 20 September 2017, the <u>Commission</u> sent its modified proposal ¹, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 20 September 2017².
- 3. The <u>European Central Bank</u> delivered its opinion on 4 October 2017³.
- 4. At its plenary from 9 to 10 October 2019, the <u>European Parliament</u> approved a corrigendum to its position at first reading from 18 April 2019⁴.

- 5. At its meeting on 9 October 2019 the <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> confirmed its agreement on the European Parliament's position and invited the <u>Council</u>:
 - to approve the European Parliament's position as set out in PE-CONS 88/19 as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Luxembourg</u> abstaining and the <u>United Kingdom</u> voting against; and
 - to decide that the statements in the <u>addendum</u> to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
