Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulations (EU) No 1379/2013, (EU) No 167/2013 and (EU) No 168/2013 as regards certain reporting requirements (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- On 17 October 2023 the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Articles 43(2) and 114 1. TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 13 December 2023².
- 3. On 28 February 2024 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal (without legal linguistic revision). After finalisation of the adopted text by the legal linguists, the Parliament approved a corrigendum to that position at its plenary session of 16 to 19 September 2024. It reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council³.

- 4. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 58/24, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Slovakia</u> voting against.
- 5. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
