Attendance of EIGE at the Social Questions Working Party on 10 October 2022

The European Institute for Gender Equality (EIGE) published on 26 May 2021 the study entitled “Gender equality and the socio-economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic”, which will serve as an important source for a set of draft Council Conclusions on "Gender equality in disrupted economies: focus on the young generation" prepared by the Presidency.

On 10 October 2022, the Presidency intends to organise a meeting of the Social Questions Working Party to discuss the draft Conclusions. The Presidency intends to invite EIGE to present its report at the beginning of this meeting, before the Working Party begins its deliberations.

Against this background, the Committee of Permanent Representatives is invited to approve the attendance of two EIGE representative at the beginning of the Social Questions Working Party meeting on 10 October.
