| Subject: | Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL establishing the European Union Single Window Environment for Customs and amending Regulation (EU) No 952/2013 (first reading) - Adoption of the legislative act |

1. On 29 October 2020 the Commission sent its proposal¹, based on Articles 33, 114 and 207 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 24 March 2021².
3. On 4 October 2022 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council³.

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 33/22, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.
5. The statement for the minutes of the Council meeting is set out in the Addendum 1 to this note.
6. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
