Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on the safety of toys and repealing Directive 2009/48/EC (first reading)
	<ul> <li>Adoption of the Council's position at first reading and of the statement of the Council's reasons</li> </ul>

- 1. On 28 July 2023 the Commission submitted its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 13 December 2023<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 13 March 2024<sup>3</sup>.

- 4. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> confirmed on 11 June 2025 the provisional agreement reached by the co-legislators on the above Regulation<sup>4</sup>, after informal contacts had taken place between the Council and the European Parliament.
- 5. On 26 June 2025, the European Parliament's Committee on the Internal Market and Consumer Protection (IMCO) confirmed the provisional agreement and its Chair subsequently sent a letter to the Chair of the Permanent Representatives Committee stating that the European Parliament should, at its second reading, approve the Council's position at first reading (following a legal-linguistic revision) without amendments<sup>5</sup>.
- 6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to suggest that the Council adopt its position at first reading, as set out in 9663/25, and the statement of reasons, as set out in 9663/25 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with Austria abstaining.
- 7. The statements for the minutes of the Council are set out in the Addendum to this note.
