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Statement from Austria	
As a general remark, Austria states that it is exclusively up to the Member States to regulate minimum income protection systems – be it legislative or executive. As minimum income schemes aim at combating social exclusion, inter alia Article 153(2)(a) TFEU only allows the adoption by the European Parliament and the Council of "measures designed to encourage cooperation between Member States through initiatives aimed at improving knowledge, developing exchanges of information and best practices, promoting innovative approaches and evaluating experiences". Harmonisation of the laws and regulations of the Member States is excluded. The legal basis for these non-binding measures is Article 153(1)(j) TFEU. Subsequently, Member States shall, in strict compliance with the principle of subsidiarity, exchange information and experience by using the method of open coordination in order to develop their national systems while respecting their national competence.

Romania welcomes the approval of the <i>Council Conclusions on Improving the working and living conditions of seasonal and other mobile workers</i> , which reflect the essential role of these categories of workers in the European Union and underline the importance of protecting them.	
While the EU seasonal workers perform critical activities in the Member States and support the functioning of the Single Market, they have proven to represent a category at greater risk. In this context, they deserve a stronger protection and effective enforcement of their rights throughout the Union. Both their crucial contribution and their vulnerabilities have been strongly emphasised during the health crisis, which has unfolded since the beginning of this year.	
Approaching this issue at the European level is timely and Romania welcomes the strong emphasis on the necessity to fully apply	

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and enforce the EU and national legislation on working and living conditions and social security coordination. This would adequately protect seasonal and other mobile workers, especially in times of crisis such as the COVID-19 pandemic. We are confident that the approval of these Conclusions will bring new impetus at the EU and national level. In our view, the text could have benefited further from the explicit reference to domestic caregivers, as they provide essential personal and household care services but are often confronted with discriminatory treatment and precarious working conditions. We consider, nevertheless, that the Council Conclusions apply as well to this category of workers. Furthermore, Romania would	
have preferred a more ambitious language when calling for setting specific requirements for temporary work and recruitment agencies, together with additional elements on the information list they have to provide to workers.	
Having regard to the above, we consider important to keep this subject high on the European agenda in the forthcoming period. We are also looking forward to the Commission's assessment of the areas where the protection of seasonal workers should be enhanced and its study aimed at the challenges they face and the subsequent policy recommendations.

Italy reiterates the considerations previously expressed. Therefore, Italy does not agree with the approval of the draft reply to

Statement by Portugal Portugal is of the opinion that in this case, further extended partial access to the documents could have been given. Indeed, given the high profile of the position, Portugal considers that the concerned individuals would have been aware that by participating in the Convention, their professional information and CV details could be of increased public interest and accessible to the public. We also believe that it is important to weigh the amount of time already lapsed since the submission of these CVs (20 years). In this regard, Portugal considers that except for the personal contact details (addresses, telephone numbers and emails) and information clearly related to the private sphere of the individuals and not relevant for their nomination to the Convention (e.g. marital status and number of children), all data could have been disclosed. Furthermore, in accordance with guarantees concerning data protection of the GDPR, Portugal would agree to strikethrough all data that the persons concerned might have expressly objected to disclose., if/when consulted. Statement by Finland Finland stresses the importance of striking a balance between the principle of transparency and the right to the protection of personal data. Finland considers that public access could be granted to certain additional elements of the requested document. **Statement by Sweden** Sweden considers that the document can be fully disclosed given that the principle of transparency in this case appears to outweigh the protection of personal data. Sweden is not convinced that the subjects concerned were not aware that by participating in the Convention they approved of having these personal data examined, and that they thereby opened up for an increased examination of their person. In this context, Sweden would welcome a more detailed analysis of how the request relates to Article 9 (3) of Regulation 2018/1725.
