Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on compulsory licensing for crisis management and amending Regulation (EC) 816/2006 (first reading)
	 Adoption of the Council's position at first reading and of the statement of the Council's reasons

- 1. On 27 April 2023 the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Articles 114 and 207 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 20 September 2023².
- 3. The <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on 13 March 2024³.
- 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee confirmed on 13 June 2025 the provisional agreement reached by the co-legislators on the above Regulation⁴, after informal contacts had taken place between the Council and the European Parliament.

- 5. On 24 June 2025 the <u>European Parliament's Committee on Legal Affairs</u> (JURI) confirmed the provisional agreement. Subsequently, its Chair sent a letter to the Chair of the Permanent Representatives Committee stating that the European Parliament should, at its second reading, approve the Council's position at first reading (following a legal-linguistic revision) without amendments⁵.
- 6. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to suggest that the <u>Council</u> adopt its position at first reading, as set out in 10498/25, and the statement of reasons, as set out in 10498/25 ADD1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
