Delegations will find below the European Semester roadmap, as prepared by the Presidency and incoming Presidency.

Following established practice, the Presidency and the incoming Presidency have prepared this roadmap outlining the key steps of the 2023 European Semester.

The objectives of the roadmap are to ensure that all relevant Council configurations, and their preparatory bodies, work in a coordinated and consistent manner towards a thorough preparation of the European Council debates on the European Semester and to enable Coreper and the General Affairs Council to oversee the process.

The roadmap is divided into two phases: the first, in more detail, covers the period up to the March European Council, and the second, more indicative, covers the period between the European Council meetings in March and June 2023.

The incoming Presidency is initiating discussions with the committees with a view to coordinating the management of their work throughout the semester. The incoming Presidency will keep Coreper informed.

The Presidency and the incoming Presidency acknowledge the parliamentary dimension of the European Semester, both at national and European level, and take note of the European Parliament's intention to hold a joint debate in March 2023.

## **FIRST PHASE**

### **Run-up to the March European Council**

- Submission of draft Budgetary Plans by euro area Member States

#### **17 October 2022: Agriculture and Fisheries Council**

- Key Employment Challenges: Key messages from the Employment Committee based on the Annual Employment Performance Report and the Employment Performance Monitor - *endorsement*
- Key Social Challenges: Key messages from the Social Protection Committee based on the Annual Review of the Social Protection Performance Monitor – *endorsement*

## **End of November 2022**

Immediately after the publication of the draft Recommendation on the economic policy of the euro area, the division of labour and the coordination arrangements between committees, as well as the methods for consolidating committees' views, are confirmed.

- Committees (Economic Policy Committee in Eurogroup format, Eurogroup working group - Alternates) prepare the draft Recommendation on the economic policy of the euro area, including the joint contribution covering the employment and social aspects by the Employment Committee and the Social Protection Committee.

## **SECOND PHASE**

- (poss.) Implementation of the Stability and Growth Pact
- (poss.) Commission to publish its proposal for a Council Decision on Guidelines for the employment policies of the Member States

#### **End of May 2023**

- Immediately after publication of the country-specific recommendations, division of labour and coordination and cooperation arrangements between committees as well as the methods for consolidating committee views will be confirmed

#### **Early June 2023**

- Economic Financial Committee, Economic Policy Committee in Eurogroup format, Eurogroup working group - Alternates, Employment Committee and Social Protection Committee preparatory work on the 2023 country-specific recommendations.
