The Commission presented the barometer which aims to provide an overall picture of the Schengen area, on the basis of indicators. Frontex presented the Strategic Risk Analysis 2022, which provides a projection of how megatrends and possible future events might affect EU border and migration management between now and 2032. On the basis of the two presentations, the Mixed Committee at Ministerial level held an exchange of views on the overall state of the Schengen area, with a particular focus on the management of external borders. They committed to a series of priority actions in the fields of border management, returns, implementation of IT systems, new legislation, external dimension and secondary movements
