Whereas:

- The terms of office of 13 Judges and five Advocates-General of the Court of Justice are due to expire on 6 October 2024.
- (2) Appointments to those posts should therefore be made for the term of office starting on 7 October 2024 and expiring on 6 October 2030.
- (3) That being the case, it has been proposed that the term of office of Mr Andreas KUMIN as Judge of the Court of Justice be renewed.
- (4) The panel set up by Article 255 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union has given a favourable opinion on the suitability of the candidate to perform the duties of Judge of the Court of Justice,

Article 1

Mr Andreas KUMIN is hereby appointed Judge to the Court of Justice for the period from 7 October 2024 to 6 October 2030.
