The SCA took note of the positions of the delegations and of the Commission on 12656/1/15 REV 1; these positions will be taken into account by the Presidency in future work.

In preparation for the second trilogue with the European Parliament, the SCA issued the Presidency with a revised mandate based on 13675/15, as amended on the basis of the conclusions drawn by the Presidency following the SCA's examination, without prejudice to any subsequent adjustments which may be made to the mandate. This mandate indicates that the Council has, in principle, partially eased its position as regards the inclusion of the EP's request concerning the total amount of aid granted under the programme. The SCA noted that this is conditional on the European Parliament making a similar compromise as regards the substance of the proposal, and that it takes into account the existence of safeguards throughout the negotiation process.
