	- Preparation of the trilogues

Delegations will find hereafter a 4-column document with the Presidency's suggested approach on Articles 4, 9, 10, 12new, 15, 37, 37new, 38, 48 and 48new for a mandate in view of upcoming trilogues.

The Presidency underlines that:

- where the European Parliament has not put forward an amendment, the Presidency will as a principle defend the partial Council's General Approach;
- for Annex I, II and IV, the Presidency suggests not to support any of the amendments introduced by the European Parliament and defend the partial Council's General Approach;
- recitals will need to be examined once an agreement has been reached on the related Articles, and are thus currently excluded from the suggested approach.
