Delegations will find attached additional suggestions by the Presidency on two issues:

- Fishing authorisations (Article 7 of Regulation (EC) No 1224/2009); and
- "Lisbonisation" of one provision (Article 49 of Regulation (EC) No 1224/2009).

The suggestions are based on proposals by the Commission, brought forward during the inter-institutional negotiations.

Note: This document sets out additional suggestions by the Presidency on two issues: (1) Fishing authorisations (Article 7 of Regulation (EC) No 1224/2009 (Control Regulation)) and (2) "Lisbonisation" of one provision (Article 49 of the Control Regulation). The suggestions are based on proposals by the Commission, brought forward during the inter-institutional negotiations.

As regards the issue of fishing authorisations, the Commission's proposals and suggestions by the Presidency result from the fact that in certain cases fishing vessels other than catching vessels must have a licence, in particular, due to international obligations of the Union. The currently applicable definition of "fishing authorisation" set out in Article 4(10) of the Control Regulation and the modifications proposed by the Council in its General Approach, in particular, in Article 6(1), suggest that only catching vessels can have fishing authorisations. The proposals outlined in this document address this issue and provide a possible solution. Please note that the discussion on exemptions in Article 7(6) of the Control Regulation (row 169) is different from that topic and that row 169 appears in the tables set out in doc ST 14148 INIT and doc ST 14148 ADD1.
