Subject:	Proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation (EU) No 216/2013 on the electronic publication of the Official Journal of the European Union - Adoption

1. On 23 February 2017, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation (EU) No 216/2013 on the electronic publication of the Official Journal of the European Union¹.
2. The text was first discussed in the meeting of the Working Party on e-Law (e-Law) on 16 May 2017.
3. Delegations made comments in writing over the summer of 2017.
4. Following the meeting of the Working Party on e-Law (e-Law) on 17 October 2017, comments were integrated into the proposal and a revised text was drawn up².

5. Delegations confirmed their agreement on the revised text at the level of the Working Party on e-Law (e-Law) in writing. All expressed scrutiny reservations have been lifted.
 6. The text has been subjected for revision by the lawyer-linguists of the Council. The resulting text is set out in document 14463/17.
 7. The revised text was forwarded to the European Parliament for consent in accordance with Article 352 TFEU. Its consent was granted on 23 October 2018.
 8. In light of the above, Coreper/Council is invited to adopt the Regulation as set out in 14463/17.
