Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1612/68 of 15 October 1968 on freedom of movement for workers within the Community¹, and in particular Articles 26 and 27 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) In its Decision of 25 September 2008², the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2010.
- (2) Two seats as members in the government representatives category have fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Mr Peter BODE and Ms Seonaid WEBB.
