# Proposal for a

#### COUNCIL DECISION

on the position to be taken on behalf of the European Union in the 33rd meeting of the Energy Charter Conference

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, and in particular Articles 194(2) and the first subparagraph of Article 207(4), in conjunction with Article 218(9) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the European Commission,

#### Whereas:

- (1) The Energy Charter Treaty ('the Agreement') was concluded by the Union by Council and Commission Decision 98/181/EC, ECSC, Euratom of 23 September 1997 on the conclusion, by the European Communities, of the Energy Charter Treaty and the Energy Charter Protocol on energy efficiency and related environmental aspects (OJ L 69, 9.3.1998, pp. 1-116) and entered into force on 16 April 1998.
- (25) In the absence of any substantial update of the Agreement since the 1990s, the Agreement became increasingly outdated. It iswas accordingly proposed appropriate to amend the Agreement with a view to to bringing it into alignment with the principles of the Paris Agreement, the requirements of sustainable development and the fight against climate change, as well as with modern standards of investment protection and investor-to-State dispute settlement.

  The amendments also aim at confirming for greater certainty that the provisions of the Agreement on investor-to-State dispute settlement and State-to-State dispute settlement do not apply, and have never applied intra-EU, as this would be contrary to Union law.

- (<u>32</u>) Pursuant to Article 34 of the Agreement, the Energy Charter Conference adopts texts of amendments to the Agreement and approves modifications of, and techholical changes to, the Annexes to the Agreement.
- The Energy Charter Conference, during its 33rd meeting on 22 November 2022, is to (i) adopt the proposed amendments to the Energy Charter Treaty Agreement (CC 760), and to approve (ii) the proposed modifications and changes to the Annexes to the Energy Charter Treaty Agreement (CC 761), (iii) the proposed changes to Understandings, Declarations and Decisions (CC 762), and (iiiiv) the decision regarding the entry into force and provisional application of amendments to the Energy Charter Treaty Agreement and changes/modifications and changes to its Annexes (CC 763), thereby concluding the negotiations conducted with a view to modernising the Agreement.
- (<u>5</u>4) It is appropriate to establish the position to be taken on the Union's behalf in the Energy Charter Conference <u>as regards matters falling within Union competence</u>, as the abovementioned acts will <u>have legal effects</u> be binding on the Union.
- (6) The position to be adopted on behalf of the Union pursuant to this Decision is without prejudice to the subsequent decision of the Union on the provisional application and conclusion of the proposed amendments to the Agreement (CC 760) pursuant to Articles 218(5) and 218(6) of the TFEU.
- (7) The proposed acts will be be adopted by the Conference if no Contracting Party objects. The Union's position should be not to raise objections, so as to allow for the adoption of the proposed acts by the Conference.

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### HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

## Article 1

The position to be taken on the Union's behalf in the 33rd meeting of the Energy Charter Conference shall be to participate in the vote and raise no objection to the following:

- (a) to support the adoption by the Conference of the proposed amendments to the Energy Charter Treaty Agreement (CC 760);
- (b) to the approvale of the proposed modifications and changes to the Annexes to the Energy Charter Treaty Agreement (CC 761);
- (c) to the approvale of the proposed changes to Understandings, Declarations and Decisions (CC 762); and
- (d) to the approvale of the decision regarding the entry into force and provisional application of amendments to the Energy Charter Treaty Agreement and ehanges/modifications and changes to its Annexes (CC 763).

#### Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption is addressed to the European Commission.
