## **CORRIGENDUM 2 TO OUTCOME OF PROCEEDINGS**

Subject: Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the enforcement of Directive 96/71/EC concerning the posting of workers in the framework of the provision of services

In the document ST 14310/1/12 REV 1:

- on page 3, paragraph 6 should read as follows:

" <u>FI</u> considered that any comprehensive assessment of the provisions in Article 13 would require more information to be given on the type of administrative penalties in use in the Member States. In its views, the choice should **not** be left to the Member States to decide if they would apply the proposed system of administrative fines and penalties in accordance with mutual recognition."

- on page 7, before the last paragraph the following should be added:

"Regarding Article 13(2) <u>FI</u> proposed to add a "public order - reservation" which would mean that if the sanctions would violate the legal system of the requested Member State, they would not have to be implemented"

- on page 13, the following changes should be made:
  - (i) the last sentence of the first paragraph should read: "<u>FI</u> stressed that the **information of** registers should be accessible only for the purposes of the Directive."
  - (ii) the third paragraph should read as follows: "Referring to Article 6(7) <u>FI</u> stated that this clause would be unnecessary if the information was **publicly** available and <u>SE</u> entered a reservation as it felt that this provision might be contrary to its Constitution.
