d) Detailed grounds for the decrease

The European Union is implementing a new customs pre-arrival security and safety programme, underpinned by a large-scale advance cargo information system - Import Control System 2 (ICS2). However, due to a delay of more than one year in the delivery of the ICS2 project and awaiting the outcome of the feasibility study in Member States that would have allowed the implementation phase, the entire ICS2 Release 4 project is pushed back in time. The corresponding underconsumption amounts to EUR 16,6 million.

At the same time, the launch of a grant agreement for the future ICS2 SSA Expert Team has been postponed to 2024, which leads to the release of another EUR 2,5 million of commitment appropriations.

In parallel, redeployment within the programme towards preparation of the customs data hub (EUR 5 million), consultancy of Union customs code (EUR 1,6 million) and a new study on the rules of origin (EUR 1 million) have been identified for an amount of EUR 7,6 million. Therefore, a total amount of EUR 11,5 million in commitment appropriations can be made available for the Semiconductors - Chips Joint Undertaking.

The European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) – Chemicals legislation realised higher fee collection revenues than budgeted. An amount of EUR 1,9 million of commitment appropriations of the EU balancing subsidy can therefore be made available for the Semiconductors - Chips Joint Undertaking.

d) Detailed grounds for the decrease

An overall surplus of EUR 0,5 million has been identified in commitment appropriations, given that IT costs for the improvement of the eForms applications are lower than initially estimated in the 2023 Draft Budget. Stakeholders in the Member States need more time than expected to make the transition to eForms, and therefore further improvements to the system are postponed to 2024. As a consequence, the budget initially earmarked for IT improvements this year can be made available.

d) Detailed grounds for the increase

The political agreement on the Chips Act was reached in April this year and the legislative act adopted and published in the Official Journal on 13 September. In the political agreement, the co-legislators invited the Commission to propose to the budgetary authority the allocation of an additional amount of EUR 50 million in the period 2023-27, with a view to reaching the targeted amount of EUR 1 575 million to be financed under the Digital Europe programme. The proposed transfer will allow covering a first tranche of it, which is requested to finance the activities of the Chips Joint Undertaking.
