Subject:	Council Decision on the position to be taken on behalf of the European Union in the Specialised Committee on Road Transport established by the Trade and Cooperation Agreement between the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community, of the one part, and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, of the other part, on the adaptation of technical specifications of the smart tachograph 2 - Adoption

1. On 13 September 2023, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Decision on the position to be taken on behalf of the European Union in the Specialised Committee on Road Transport established by the Trade and Cooperation Agreement between the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community, of the one part, and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, of the other part, on the adaptation of technical specifications of the smart tachograph 2, contained in documents ST 13533/23 + ADD 1.

2. The Commission presented the proposal on 3 October 2023 in the Working Party on the United Kingdom. On 20 October 2023, after a consultation of the Working Party on Land Transport on 9 October 2023, the Working Party on the United Kingdom found an agreement on the text with the modifications suggested by the Council Legal Service. The agreed text is contained in document ST 14007/23 + ADD 1.
 3. In light of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to:
 - confirm its agreement on the text of the above-mentioned Council Decision, as finalised by the legal-linguists and set out in document ST 14230/23 + ADD 1;
 - recommend that the Council adopts the Council Decision set out in document ST 14230/23 + ADD 1.
 4. The European Parliament will be informed of this decision in accordance with Article 218(10) TFEU.
