Subject: Joint statement on the European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA), the European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) and the European Union Agency for Criminal Justice Cooperation (Eurojust)

**DRAFT JOINT STATEMENT ON THE EUROPEAN MARITIME SAFETY AGENCY  
(EMSA), THE EUROPEAN UNION AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY (EASA) AND THE  
EUROPEAN UNION AGENCY FOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE COOPERATION  
(EUROJUST)**

In accordance with Point 27 of the Interinstitutional Agreement (IIA) of 20 December 2020, the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission agree on the following, on the basis of the information transmitted by the Commission:

- The financing of the amounts presented in the financial statement for the *European Maritime Safety Agency* (EMSA) and the *European Union Aviation Safety Agency* (EASA) can be secured within the agreed expenditure ceiling of heading 1 of the multiannual financial framework for the period 2021-2027. The annual amount and the establishment plan posts for EASA for the financial year 2023 have already been included in the 2023 budget. The annual EU contribution and the total number of establishment plan posts for EMSA and EASA for the financial years 2024-2027 will be decided in the framework of the annual budgetary procedure.
  
- The financing of the amounts presented in the financial statement for the *European Union Agency for Criminal Justice Cooperation* (Eurojust) can be secured within the agreed expenditure ceilings of heading 2b of the multiannual financial framework for the period 2021-2027. The annual amount and the establishment plan posts for Eurojust for the financial year 2023 have already been included in the 2023 budget. The annual EU contribution and the total number of establishment plan posts for Eurojust for the financial years 2024-2027 will be decided in the framework of the annual budgetary procedure.
