Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL establishing a common data platform on chemicals, laying down rules to ensure that the data contained in it are findable, accessible, interoperable and reusable and establishing a monitoring and outlook framework for chemicals (first reading) - Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 7 December 2023, the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 114(1) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 20 March 2024².
- 3. The European Data Protection Supervisor (EDPS) delivered its opinion on 29 January 2024³.

- 4. On 21 October 2025, the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal⁴. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.
- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 24/25, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.
- 6. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
