THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, and in particular Article 215 thereof,

Having regard to Council Decision (CFSP) 2025/... of ... amending Decision (CFSP) 2016/1693 concerning restrictive measures against ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaeda and persons, groups, undertakings and entities associated with them¹⁺,

Having regard to the joint proposal from the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy and the European Commission,

Whereas:

- (1) Council Regulation (EU) 2016/1686² gives effect to Council Decision (CFSP) 2016/1693³.
- (2) In view of the continued threat posed by ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaeda and persons, groups, undertakings and entities associated with them, on ...⁺ the Council adopted Decision (CFSP) 2025/...⁺⁺ in order to add one entity to the list of persons, groups, undertakings and entities subject to restrictive measures.
- (3) That entity is already subject to restrictive measures under Council Decision 2010/788/CFSP⁴ and Council Regulation (EC) No 1183/2005⁵. In order to ensure uniform implementation of the asset freeze measures, Decision (CFSP) 2025/...⁺⁺ suspends the relevant restrictive measures applicable to that entity under that Decision for as long as the measures provided for in Decision 2010/788/CFSP apply to it.

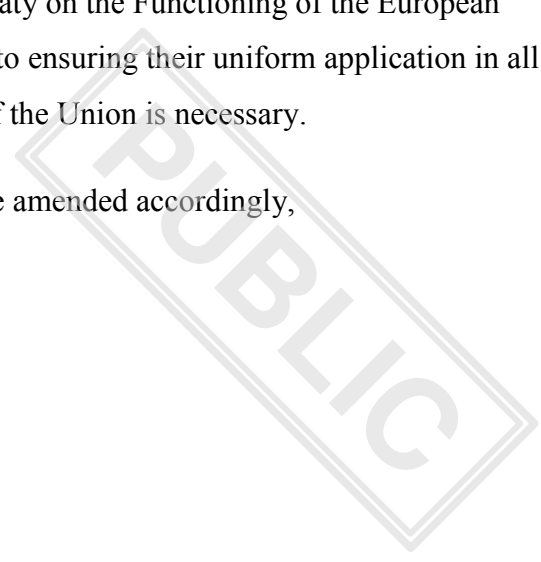

- (4) These measures fall within the scope of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union and, therefore, in particular with a view to ensuring their uniform application in all Member States, regulatory action at the level of the Union is necessary.
- (5) Regulation (EU) 2016/1686 should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:



Article 1

In Article 4 of Regulation (EU) 2016/1686, the following paragraph is added:

- ‘5. The measures referred to in Article 2(1) and (2), insofar as they apply to the “Allied Democratic Forces”, shall be suspended for as long as the measures laid down in Article 2(1) and (2) of Council Regulation (EC) No 1183/2005* apply to that entity.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the date of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
