Subject: Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Directive 2013/11/EU on alternative dispute resolution for consumer disputes and amending Directives (EU) 2015/2302, (EU) 2019/2161 and (EU) 2020/1828 following the discontinuation of the European Online Dispute Resolution Platform (**first reading**)
- Adoption of the Council's position at first reading and of the statement of the Council's reasons

1. On 17 October 2023 the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 14 February 2024².
3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 13 March 2024³.

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee confirmed on 16 July 2025 the provisional agreement reached by the co-legislators on the above Directive⁴, after informal contacts had taken place between the Council and the European Parliament.
 5. On 2 October 2025, the European Parliament's Committee on the Internal Market and Consumer Protection (IMCO) confirmed the provisional agreement. Subsequently, its Chair sent a letter to the Chair of the Permanent Representatives Committee stating that the European Parliament should, at its second reading, approve the Council's position at first reading (following a legal-linguistic revision) without amendments⁵.
 6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to suggest that the Council adopt its position at first reading, as set out in 11778/25, and the statement of reasons, as set out in 11778/25 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
