Authorisation to negotiate an NBI Decision to use the written procedure

Statement by Cyprus

"Cyprus is concerned by information regarding efforts to grant the secessionist entity in the occupied territory of the Republic of Cyprus an observer status during the upcoming Summit of the Organisation of Turkic States (11 November 2022, Samarkand, Uzbekistan), in which some Central Asia countries are members. Admitting the secessionist entity in any regional or international organisation would run contrary to international law, including UNSC resolutions 541(1983) and 550(1984). We underline that any such development would have significant repercussions, not only on Cyprus' relations with any country supporting or assisting in this effort, but also Cyprus' position vis-a-vis EU-Central Asia relations.

Furthermore, full respect to the sovereignty and territorial integrity of all states should be reaffirmed in the Joint Declaration of the EU-Central Asia Sustainable Connectivity Conference."
