Subject: Proposal for a Council Decision on the conclusion, on behalf of the European Union, of the United Nations Convention on the International Effects of Judicial Sales of Ships, adopted by the United Nations General Assembly in New York on 7 December 2022 (the "Beijing Convention on the Judicial Sale of Ships") - Agreement in principle - Request for the consent of the European Parliament

In the document 14920/25 INIT on page 1, paragraph 1 should read as follows:

- "1. The United Nations Convention on the International Effects of Judicial Sales of Ships, was adopted by the United Nations General Assembly in New York on 7 December 2022 (the "Beijing Convention on the Judicial Sale of Ships"). The Commission then submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Decision on the signing of this Convention, which was adopted on 21 December 2023¹."

On page 2, paragraph 5 should read as follows:

“5. The text of the Convention is available in all languages as documents 15716/23 and 15716/1/23 REV 1, depending on the language.”

On page 2, paragraph 6 should read as follows:

"6. In view of the above, it is recommended for the Permanent Representatives Committee to invite the Council to:

- a) agree in principle on the draft Decision on the conclusion of the Convention and the attached relevant declaration of competences, as finalised by the legal-linguistic experts (14882/25 + ADD 1);
- b) decide to forward the draft Decision on the conclusion of the Convention, to which the Convention is attached, as finalised by the legal-linguistic experts, to the European Parliament for its consent. "
