Subject:	5G Roadmap
	- Information from the Presidency

On 18 July 2017, Ministers signed a 5G declaration "Making 5G a success for Europe" <sup>1</sup> confirming their willingness to position Europe as the global lead market for 5G.

On 19 October, the European Council noted that:

To successfully build a Digital Europe, the EU needs in particular (...) a first rate infrastructure and communications network: this requires cooperation at the EU level, inter alia with the aim of achieving world-class very high-speed fixed and mobile networks (5G) all across the EU and increased coordinated availabilities of spectrum by 2020 under consistent regulatory and economic conditions;<sup>2</sup>

Following this strong political signal, the Estonian Presidency organised on 3 November a high level group meeting in Tallinn with representatives from Member States to discuss the possible establishment of a 5G roadmap to ensure the timely and predictable availability of the required spectrum.

The Presidency will inform the Council of the outcome of the work on this 5G roadmap.
