<u>The Council</u> took note of the information provided by the High Representative on the outlook for the December European Council, Bolivia, Libya, Hong Kong, Iran/JCPOA and the Republic of Moldova.

# 4. <u>EU-Africa relations, with a view to preparations for the forthcoming EU-AU ministerial and summit-level meetings</u>

Exchange of views

<u>The Council</u> had a forward-looking discussion on EU-Africa relations that will feed into the preparations of a new comprehensive EU strategy on Africa. The <u>Ministers</u> agreed on the need for a comprehensive strategy, to be prepared together with the African partners, and covering a broad range of issues related to the EU-Africa relationship, including digital, youth and climate.

## 5. <u>Promoting and protecting human rights in the world,</u> particularly in view of the Human Rights Day

Exchange of views

<u>The Council</u> had an exchange of views on a broad range of human rights issues, also with a view to the upcoming renewed Action Plan on Human Rights and Democracy. The Council also reached agreement in principle on a future establishment of an EU global human rights sanctions regime.

#### 6. Any other business

The <u>Hungarian</u> delegation informed the Council about the Hungarian initiative at the UN for an **International Day Commemorating the Victims of Communist Dictatorships**.

The <u>Italian</u> delegation informed the Council of the outcome of the **MED - Mediterranean Dialogues Conference** held in Rome 5-7 December 2019.

The <u>Irish</u> delegation debriefed the Council about a ministerial visit to the **Middle East**.
