**ANNEX**

In Annex III to Directive 2011/65/EU, entry 2(b)(4) is replaced by the following:

Exemption		Scope and dates of applicability
2(b)(4)-I	Lamps for other general lighting and special purposes (e.g. induction lamps): 15 mg	Expires on [PO: three years <a href="#">after the publication of the Delegated Directive in the Official Journal</a> ]
2(b)(4)-II	Lamps emitting mainly light in the ultraviolet spectrum: 15 mg	Expires on [PO: five years <a href="#">after the publication of the Delegated Directive in the Official Journal</a> ]
2(b)(4)-III	Emergency lamps: 15 mg	Expires on [five years <a href="#">after the publication of the Delegated Directive in the Official Journal</a> ]
