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Subject: Council Regulation amending Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2020/2093 laying down the multiannual financial framework for the years 2021 to 2027

- *Adoption of the legislative act*
- *Decision to use the written procedure for the adoption of the Council's position at first reading and of the statement of the Council reasons*
- *Decision to derogate from the eight-week period provided for in Article 4 of Protocol 1 on the role of national parliaments in the EU*

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1. On 9 November 2022, the Commission submitted a proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2020/2093 laying down the multiannual financial framework for the years 2021 to 2027<sup>1</sup>. The proposed Council Regulation is part of the package of proposals on financing the support to Ukraine, together with the Commission's proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing an instrument to provide support to Ukraine for 2023 (macro-financial assistance +)<sup>2</sup> and the Commission's proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 as regards the establishment of a diversified funding strategy as a general borrowing method<sup>3</sup>.

2. In accordance with Article 312(2) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, the Council may adopt the Regulation acting unanimously and after obtaining the consent of the European Parliament.
3. On 18 November 2022, the draft Council Regulation was forwarded to the European Parliament for its consent.
4. The European Parliament gave its consent to the draft Regulation at the Plenary session on 24 November 2022<sup>4</sup>.
5. In order to allow the Council to adopt the draft Council Regulation without delay, the Council has to decide, considering the urgency of the matter, to shorten, in accordance with Article 3(3) of its Rules of Procedure, the eight-week period laid down in Article 4 of Protocol No 1 on the role of national Parliaments in the European Union.
6. In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to:
  - recommend to the Council to adopt the text of the draft Council Regulation as finalised by the legal/linguistic experts and set out in in document 14471/1/22 REV 1 and REV 2 (de);
  - decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure, that, in view of urgency of the matter, the Council uses the written procedure for the adoption of the draft Council Regulation as finalised by the legal/linguistic experts and set out in in document 14471/1/22 REV 1 and REV 2 (de) and for the decision to derogate, on the basis of the second subparagraph of Article 3(3) of the Council's Rules of Procedure, from the eight-week period referred to in the first subparagraph of that Article.

After being signed by the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
