Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL establishing a European single access point providing centralised access to publicly available information of relevance to financial services, capital markets and sustainability (first reading)  - Adoption of the legislative act
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 25 November 2021 the Commission submitted its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Central Bank</u> delivered its opinion on 7 June 2022<sup>2</sup>.
- The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 23 March 2022<sup>3</sup>. 3.
- 4. On 9 November 2023 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>4</sup>.

- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE CONS 42/23, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
- 6. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
