Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EU) No 909/2014 as regards settlement discipline, cross-border provision of services, supervisory cooperation, provision of banking-type ancillary services and requirements for third-country central securities depositories and amending Regulation (EU) No 236/2012 (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- On 16 March 2022 the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 114 TFEU, to 1. the Council.
- 2. The European Central Bank delivered its opinion on 28 July 2022².
- 3. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 14 July 2022³.
- 4. On 9 November 2023 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council⁴.

- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE CONS 47/23, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting
- 6. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the <u>Addendum</u> to this note.
- 7. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
