	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 23 February 2022, the <u>Commission</u> submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 15 June 2022².
- 3. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> delivered its opinion on 30 June 2022³.
- 4. The <u>European Central Bank</u> delivered its opinion on 5 September 2022⁴.

- 5. On 9 November 2023, the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council⁵.
- 6. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 49/23, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.
- 7. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
