4. **Organisation of future work**

The Presidency informed the SCA about the SCA meeting on 24 November and the "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council meeting on 17 November 2025.

Regarding that Council meeting,

- Germany requested a public item under “any other business”, on the “Statistics on the use of plant protection products (according to EU SAIO)”;
- Italy requested an item under “any other business”, on the Ministerial meeting held in Vercelli on 12-14 September 2025, on “The future of EU rice sector: a common strategy”; and
- Belgium requested an item under “any other business”, on the “Chinese anti-dumping investigation on European pork – The need for a level-playing field”.

- The SCA agreed that the “any other business” item requested by Germany would be taken in public session in accordance with Article 8(2) of the rules of procedure of the Council.

The Presidency also reiterated some suggestions regarding the streamlining of current work practices related to “any other business” items at “Agriculture and Fisheries” Council meetings, and further informed the SCA about the measures it took with the GSC to remedy some interpretation issues.
