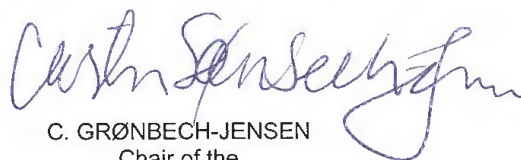
Dear Mr Lange,

contain no amendments to the Commission's proposal (subject to the revision by the lawyers-

Treaty, approve the European Parliament's position and the act shall be adopted in the wording
which corresponds to the European Parliament's position.

On behalf of the Council, I also wish to thank you for the close cooperation which should enable us to reach agreement on this file at first reading.
