Subject:	Joint Statement on the launching of the Critical Raw Materials Club
	- Approval of a non-binding instrument

- 1. On 11 August 2023, the Trade Policy Committee (Deputies) was informed by the Commission, in a note, of its intention to commence negotiations on a non-binding instrument in the form of a Joint Statement on the launching of the Critical Raw Materials (CRM) Club.
- 2. On 9 November 2023, the Council authorised the Commission to negotiate, on behalf of the European Union, a Joint Statement on the launching of the CRM Club.¹
- 3. The Commission presented the text of the draft Joint Statement, as set out in document ST 15822/23, at the meeting of the Trade Policy Committee (Deputies) on 23 November 2023. During the discussion, no delegation raised objections to that text.
- 4. The representatives of the EU and other members of the CRM Club intend to launch the CRM Club in a dedicated event to be held in the margins of the Climate Change Conference (COP28) on 2 December 2023.
