¹ This figure includes climate finance sources from public budgets and other development financial institutions and is calculated based on commitments for bilateral and disbursements of multilateral contributions, as reported by Member States on the basis of Article 19.3 of Regulation (EU) 2018/1999 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2018. It also includes EUR 4.0 billion climate finance from the EU Budget and the European Development Fund, and EUR 5.7 billion from the European Investment Bank.

² The figure regards the private financial support mobilised through public interventions (guarantees, syndicated loans, direct investment in companies, credit lines, etc.). It does not include any amounts of public finance utilised for the mobilisation of this private financial support.
