"Implementation of assistance measures under the European Peace Facility until 30 September 2025"

Main findings

In line with Article 63 of the Council Decision (CFSP) 2021/509 of 22 March 2021 establishing a European Peace Facility (hereafter EPF CD), the High Representative (HR) hereby presents the ninth report on the implementation of assistance measures (AMs) under the EPF. These main findings focus on the second and third quarters of 2025 to align the reporting period with timeline of the new strategic orientations as per the updated EPF CD.

The report provides an update on the political and financial aspects of support provided under the adopted AMs and approved actions¹ up to 30 September 2025. It also provides an overview of monitoring activities related to commitments stemming from HR arrangements with beneficiaries². The report contains a political overview of the main findings focusing on the period from 1 April 2025 to 30 September 2025. It is accompanied by an annex covering each AM since the inception of the EPF.

Four years after the EPF was established, we are now at a stage where implementation of EPF AMs is well underway and yielding concrete results. The Facility's dual role in providing military assistance to third countries as well as financing the common costs of CSDP military missions and operations has reinforced regional security architectures and incentivised third countries to enhance their partnerships with the EU and cooperate on shared security policy objectives. Following significant reinforcements, the EPF financial ceiling now equals over EUR 17 billion for the 2021–2027 period. The EPF supports partners in the area of military and defence with a global geographical scope and a 360-degree approach, with strategic priorities focused on areas where the EPF can best advance the security interests of the EU and its partners. By 30 September 2025, AMs with 32 beneficiaries had been adopted, including 28 bilateral partners and four African-led Peace Support Operations (PSOs)³.

During 2025, the number of AMs delayed or blocked during the adoption process multiplied, which has a significant impact on the EPF's efficiency and partners' perception of the EU's effectiveness as a global security provider.

1. EPF support by region

1.1 The Eastern Neighbourhood

Providing urgent and relevant support to Ukraine, including military support through both equipping and training the Armed Forces of Ukraine (AFU), has been a priority for the EU since the onset of Russia's illegal and unjustified war of aggression. Collectively, the EU and its Member States have

provided over EUR 63.2 billion⁴ worth of military support to Ukraine since the start of the Russian military aggression in 2022. On 24 February, the High Representative proposed an initiative for enhanced EU military support to Ukraine with the objective to mobilise 2 million large calibre artillery shells for the benefit of Ukraine in 2025, in line with the request made in March by President Zelenskyy of Ukraine. While this support falls outside the EPF, it is partially funded through accrued interest on immobilised Russian assets that are in part channelled through the instrument.

EUR 6.6 billion, including the EUR 5 billion Ukraine Assistance Fund (UAF) in reimbursements that remain blocked due to the position of one Member State continue to have a financial impact on the Facility and on Member States contributing to or expecting reimbursement from the EPF. **DELETED**

Looking beyond Ukraine, support to the Eastern Neighbourhood countries continues to be prioritised. Due to its vicinity to Ukraine and the resulting vulnerabilities, Moldova continued to receive high levels of support, with a first EPF AM providing lethal equipment (air defence) being agreed by the Council in 2024 and a second one adopted in 2025. A second AM for the benefit of Armenia was also presented to Member States in February but had not been adopted by the end of the reporting period.

1.2. Western Balkans

In the Western Balkans, engagement at both the regional and bilateral level remains of strategic interest to the EU. Implementation of AMs continues for Bosnia and Herzegovina, North Macedonia, Albania, Montenegro and the Balkan Medical Task Force (BMTF) as an AM benefitting the region and promoting cooperation among its members. New bilateral AMs have been approved for North Macedonia and Albania since the last HR implementation report was submitted, complementing previous bilateral AMs in both cases.

1.3. Southern Neighbourhood

EPF engagement in the Southern Neighbourhood has increased significantly in response to continued conflict and instability. Notably, the exceptional additional AM adopted in January 2025 providing EUR 60 million in support of the Lebanese Armed Forces in order to support their redeployment to the South Litani Sector, in line with UN Security Council Resolution 1701 (2006), has provided important and timely support for national and regional security throughout the reporting period. This AM brought the total support to Lebanon since 2022 to EUR 82 million.

1.4 Africa

Implementation continued for AMs benefiting both the military components of African-led PSOs (G5 Sahel Joint Force, African Union Transition Mission in Somalia (ATMIS), G5 Sahel Joint Force and the Multinational Joint Task Force (MNJTF) in the Lake Chad basin) and partners bilaterally (Benin, Cabo Verde, Cameroon, Republic of the Congo, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Djibouti, Ghana, Côte d'Ivoire, Kenya, Mauritania, the Rwandan deployment in Mozambique, Senegal, Somalia, and Togo).

In **West Africa**, EPF support is provided along a dual track, assisting both land forces to counter jihadist threats emanating from the Sahel in synergy with the EU Security and Defence Initiative (EUSDI), as relevant, and naval forces to strengthen maritime security in the Atlantic and the Gulf of Guinea, including in the context of Yaoundé Architecture, complementing the EU Coordinated Maritime Presence (CMP) in the Gulf of Guinea.

EPF support also allows the MNJTF to fulfil its mandate effectively and counter Boko Haram's activities in the Lake Chad Basin. The crucial role the EU plays in this regard has been recognised by African Union Commission (AUC) and the Lake Chad Basin Commission (LCBC).

In **East Africa**, 2025 saw continued support to Somalia through the transfer of numerous assets to the Somali National Army in conjunction with continued discussions on the African Union Support and Stabilisation Mission in Somalia (AUSSOM), which replaced ATMIS on 1 January 2025.

The EU continued supporting partners across Africa and fulfilled its commitment to support African-led PSOs mandated by the AU through the extended multi-annual AM/GP-AU for 2022–2024.

2. Impact of the EPF

Overall, the EPF has contributed to strengthening the EU's position as a reliable security provider worldwide and has enhanced the EU's visibility in partner countries. More and more partners are aware of the instrument and are interested in benefiting from it as part of a strengthening their cooperation on security and defence with the EU. The EPF offers both concrete operational support and, in an increasingly competitive geopolitical context, helps the EU establish itself as a trusted partner that is able to deliver comparatively quickly, while fostering strong local ownership.

In many cases, EPF support has contributed to more concrete discussions with partner countries on their needs in the area of defence development, including defence transformation projects, and has deepened the EU's situational awareness about the defence readiness of selected partners.

EPF support has also contributed to a more in-depth exchange with EU Member States and international partners on the ground and informed discussions with NATO and the African Union Commission, among others. The EPF has strengthened bilateral relations, and increased the EU's influence in partner countries, effectively complementing existing channels of cooperation as part of the EU's Integrated Approach.

In line with Article 9 of the EPF CD, the Political and Security Committee (PSC) is invited to take due account of this reporting in view of the PSC discussion on the indicative strategic orientation for AMs and operations in 2026.

3. Horizontal activities

3.1. Financial sustainability of the EPF

Following two successive top ups in 2023 and a decision to increase the overall envelope in 2024, the EPF financial ceiling now equals over EUR 17 billion for the 2021–2027 period. This includes the allocations foreseen for the Ukraine Assistance Fund (UAF), EUR 5 billion. Discussions are underway regarding the envelope for EPF for the upcoming budgetary period of 2028–2035.

3.2. Safeguards and monitoring

3.2.1 Beneficiary arrangements and reporting

HR arrangements with beneficiaries remain a priority as a prerequisite for the implementation of Assistance Measures (AM) or an actions under the AM/GP-AU. Continued monitoring has provided awareness of the context and risks of breaches of the obligations established in Beneficiary arrangements, and is intended to contribute to the prevention of such breaches, including violations of international human rights law and international humanitarian law. Annual reporting obligations for the beneficiary aim to mitigate risk and provide input to the monitoring process. It also ensures follow-up of the support delivered under the EPF and tracing of sensitive assets. Furthermore, it allows to draw lessons on the use and consumption of items that were delivered under the EPF and contributes to promoting accountability within the recipient military forces.

Because most AMs are still in the implementing phase, reception of the majority of first annual reports from beneficiaries on the application of the AMs after their implementation is not expected before the end of 2027.

However, due to the quantity and importance of deliveries of military equipment, for Ukraine a first reporting exercise was already launched in June 2023. DELETED

A similar reporting exercise with regard to equipment delivered to Mozambique has been initiated in 2024 to familiarize the Mozambican Armed Forces (FADM) with such a process. After some delays, Mozambique delivered a first report covering 2024. The report covering 2025 is to be launched. It will combine selected equipment which was delivered under the AM in support to the FADM and equipment supplied under the EPF to the Southern African Development Community Mission in Mozambique (SAMIM) which was then transferred to the FADM after the closedown of SAMIM.

3.2.2. Risk Management

Risk management for proposed AMs and actions under the AM/GP-AU has been ensured by seeking information from all relevant internal and external stakeholders, such as NATO, EU MS and partner countries, the UN, the ICRC, as well as international and local NGOs and think tanks. This network provides relevant information for risk assessments as well as for monitoring purposes.

Based on the risk assessments carried out, specific mitigating measures have been proposed in AMs and actions under the AM/GP-AU to address the identified risks.

Financial implementation risks are managed by the Administrator for assistance measures by applying relevant control systems to revenue collection and expenditure operations. This comprises putting in place mitigation measures proportionate to the financial risk assessment at contractual level, including requiring contingency planning from the implementing actors, as appropriate.

In addition, the EEAS and the Administrator for AMs review transversal risks together on a regular basis, i.e. risks affecting the political, operational, and/or financial aspects of AMs during the different phases of their lifecycle (preparation, implementation and post-delivery phases) and which can be assessed and/or addressed more effectively jointly by the two services – within the scope of their respective responsibilities – rather than individually by each service.

3.2.3. Evaluation of assistance measures

As the first AMs are coming to an end, the evaluation of the support should contribute to the design of future measures as well as procedures and safeguards. The first set of final evaluations to be carried out by the High Representative is expected to be launched shortly.

For this purpose, the development of a performance monitoring system, including in particular the creation of monitoring indicators and of an evaluation framework, is ongoing.

3.3. Information policy

The EEAS has followed an active and transparent information policy providing the Council, the European Parliament, research, local and international NGOs, citizens and the media, as appropriate, with regular updates on the state of play of support to third countries under the EPF, as appropriate, while respecting the relevant provisions of CFSP.

Civil society actors as well as local and international human rights and humanitarian organisations in beneficiary countries and in Brussels have been consulted on the monitoring and human rights-related aspects of the support.

3.4. Communication activities

Throughout 2025, the EEAS continued to issue press releases, x-posts and publications on the EEAS website on the occasion of the adoption of AMs and the approval of actions, as well as for deliveries of EPF-financed equipment in beneficiary countries. The Administrator for AMs has also communicated through press releases and x-posts on main milestones during the implementation of AMs, such as deliveries of equipment. EU Delegations have communicated through appropriate channels locally (press releases, x-posts, Facebook posts and broadcasting), with the support of EEAS Stratcom. EU DELs have also organised handover ceremonies for EPF-financed equipment on several occasions, including during high-level visits from Brussels. They have contributed their analysis on disinformation campaigns on the EU in general and relating to EPF support in particular where relevant. Frequent media requests were addressed by the EEAS in a coordinated manner via the Spokesperson's Service (SPP), including on the EU's military support to Ukraine. The High Representative communicated on the EPF regularly during her interactions with the media. The EEAS prepared lines to take and narratives for specific EPF AMs that faced particular scrutiny by the media.

The EEAS (including EU DELs) and the Administrator for AMs have jointly coordinated their respective work on communication and visibility products on the EPF, including on the occasion of equipment deliveries to beneficiary countries and high-level visits or the EPF's anniversary.
