The SCA took note of the Presidency's oral debrief on the informal trilogue on the horizontal approach to the alignment of agricultural legislation with the Lisbon Treaty which took place on 19 and 25 October 2011, as well as of the comments made by the Commission representative.

The SCA also noted the views expressed by the representative of the Council Legal Service on the alignment exercise, as well as the Presidency's intention to return to this dossier on 21 November with a view to obtaining an adjusted negotiating mandate.

The <u>SCA</u> took note of the information provided by the Commission and of the comments by delegations. The <u>Presidency</u> noted that there did not seem to be a qualified majority in favour of the text of the Commission proposal. The Presidency informed the SCA that it would forward the outcome of the meeting, on an informal basis, to the European Parliament and would reflect on how to take the work on this file forward.

6. Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Council Regulation (EC) No 1234/2007 as regards contractual relations in the milk and milk products sector

The <u>Special Committee on Agriculture</u> had an exchange of views on new suggestions made by the Presidency with a view to revising its mandate for the trilogue of 10 November 2011.

The <u>Special Committee on Agriculture</u> endorsed the intention of the Presidency to engage in exploratory talks "ad referendum" with the European Parliament in order to identify the outline of a possible overall agreement on the basis of its suggestions as revised in the light of the discussion held during this meeting.

The <u>Presidency</u> confirmed its intention to circulate a revised document to delegations prior to the trilogue and recalled that "nothing was agreed until everything is agreed".

<u>The Presidency</u> informed the SCA on the organisation of the Council "Agriculture and Fisheries" meeting on 14 November 2011.
