The Committee:

The Presidency briefed on the successful outcome of the summit which launched a new EU/Africa Strategic Partnership, and called - in accordance with European Council Conclusions of 14 December 2007 - for additional and combined efforts of all relevant actors to reach within the next three years concrete and tangible results in the implementation of the Partnership and its First Action Plan.

<u>The Committee</u> discussed and agreed the extension of the mandate of the ad hoc working party in accordance with the mandate as set out in document 16693/3/07 REV 3.

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Taking into account the discussions in the ad hoc working party as well as a Presidency Note for the Committee "Implementation of the Joint EU/Africa Action Plan", the Committee agreed in principle to establish under the supervision of the ad hoc working group core groups to implement the First Action Plan.

<u>The Committee</u> agreed to decide on the revision of existing Africa-related EU working arrangements by the end of April and before the expiry of the mandate of the ad hoc working party.

48. Setting of the provisional agenda for the Council meeting (Agriculture and Fisheries) on 21 and (poss.) 22 January 2008 (For the items within the remit of the Permanent Representatives Committee)

<u>The Commission representative</u> requests the inclusion as a B-item for adoption of its proposal for a Council Decision on the termination of the Protocol setting out the fishing opportunities and financial contribution under the Fisheries Partnership Agreement between the European Community and the Islamic Republic of Mauritania.

<u>The Spanish delegation</u> opposes the inclusion of this point referring to the exchange of views under AOB on the issue in the Council the previous day. It requests a written opinion of the Council Legal Service on the need for an opinion of the European Parliament in order for Council to be able to decide on the termination of the protocol and on the need of a previous impact assessment of such a termination.

<u>The French, German, Greek, Latvian, Lithuanian and Netherlands delegations</u> support the views of the Spanish delegation and urge the Commission to seek alternative solutions (e.g. the Joint Committee).

The Council Legal service makes an oral intervention pointing out that:

- The Commission has the right to request the inclusion of the item on the agenda and that the purpose of the debate (for instance, exchange of views, general approach or adoption) can be designated later.
- An opinion of the European Parliament is necessary in order for the Council to decide to terminate the protocol. The Decision proposed can therefore only be adopted after consulting the European Parliament.
- The Council may consult the European Parliament. To do so, the legal basis of the proposal (Article 300(2) of the Treaty) would have to be changed to Article 300(3). If the Commission does not agree to this modification, the change of legal basis can be done by the Council acting by unanimity.
- The Legal Service reserves its position on the issue of the need for an impact assessment until its forthcoming written opinion.

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<u>The Commission representative</u> contests the need for an opinion of the Parliament since the proposal intends to terminate only the protocol, and not the agreement itself.

<u>The Committee</u> adopts the draft agenda with the addition of the requested B-item without a designation of the purpose of the debate.
