1. By an application notified to the Council on 19 November 2024, Viktor Fedorovych Yanukovych has brought an action, pursuant to Article 263 TFEU, for the annulment of Council Decision (CFSP) 2024/2456 of 12 September 2024 amending Decision 2014/145/CFSP, as well as the Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/2455 of 12 September 2024 implementing Council Regulation (EU) no 269/2014, concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine, insofar as they apply to the applicant, and for ordering the Council to pay the costs of the proceedings.
2. The Applicant invokes a single plea in law in support of its application alleging that the Council made a manifest error of assessment in determining that the designation criterion had been satisfied.
3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed **DELETED** and **DELETED**, legal advisers in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case. They will be assisted by **DELETED**.
