1. By an application notified to the Council on 6 December 2024, SBK ART LLC has brought an action, pursuant to Article 263, 275(2) and 277 TFEU, for the inapplicability of Article 2(1) final paragraph of Council Decision (CFSP) 2014/145, as amended by Council Decision (CFSP) 2022/329, and of Article 3(1) final paragraph of Council Regulation (EU) 269/2014, as amended by Council Regulation (EU) 2022/330; and for the annulment of Council Decision (CFSP) 2024/2456 amending Council Decision (CFSP) 2014/145, as well as of Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/2455 implementing Regulation (EU) 269/2014, in so far as they apply to the applicant; and, finally, to order the Council to pay the costs.
2. The Applicant invokes four pleas in law in support of its application alleging that the Council:
  - violated its rights of defence;
  - made an error of assessment;
  - adopted disproportionate restrictive measures against it;
  - infringed the obligation to state reasons;
3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed **DELETED** and **DELETED**, legal advisers in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in Case T-607/24.
